Responsibilities

- A daily temperature check & health screening for all employees will be performed
- Employees will wear masks during food service and in places where personal distance can't be maintained
- We will disinfect every building used before and after a group leaves
- We will place hard limits on group sizes
- Hand sanitizer will be available around camp
- Mobile washing stations will be placed around camp
- We will place personal distance markings and traffic direction arrows in high traffic areas
- There will be mandatory temperature checks for **ALL** at arrival (less than 100.00 F)
- We will disinfect high traffic surfaces regularly
- We will place signage throughout camp about Coronavirus prevention practices

Your Group's Responsibilities

- Monitor and enforce personal distance between your group
- Wear masks when personal distance can't be maintained
- Instruct your participants on hand washing, coughing, and sneezing best practices
- Create and have participants complete a Coronavirus questionnaire for your own knowledge
- Instruct any potential participant that has shown signs of respiratory illness in the past 2 weeks or has come into contact with someone who has, to stay at home.
- Temp check your participants before you travel together to CLS (less than 100.00 F)
 - If one person has a high temp when they arrive at camp, **all** will be sent home
- Inform CLS staff of **ANY** potential respiratory illness on our property immediately

SAMPLE Coronavirus Questionnaire

1. Have you or your child been diagnosed with a respiratory illness within the past 2 weeks?
2. Have you or your child come into contact with someone who has been diagnosed with Coronavirus in the past 2 weeks?
3. Have you or your child had a fever over 100.00 F in the past 2 weeks?
4. Have you or your child exhibited any symptoms of illness like cough, shortness of breath, chills, or sore throat?
5. Have you or your child exhibited loss of tastes or smell or diarrhea within the past 24 hours?
6. Are there any underlying medical conditions that might put you or your child more at risk for contraction of Coronavirus?

All 6 questions are questions asked by the Mississippi Health Department to determine whether or not someone might have or is at high risk for contracting Coronavirus. You can certainly add more questions if you require more information, but these 6 are a sufficient pre-screening to understand about Coronavirus infection. If yes is answered for any of these questions the participant should stay home.
